

Disability Parking Permit – Conditions of Use

Using your permit

1. A disability parking permit is not valid beyond its expiry date or if the expiry date or the permit number is not legible.
2. The disability parking permit must be clearly displayed by hanging the permit from the rear view mirror, with the expiry date and permit number visible to an authorised officer.
3. The permit must be hung when the vehicle is parked and removed prior to driving.
4. Alteration or reproduction of the disabled parking permit is unauthorised and against the law. Council may impose penalties for misuse of the permit.
5. We may cancel a disability parking permit at any time for wilful misuse or breach of the “Conditions of Use”.
6. The driver using the permit must either be the permit holder or must be parking the vehicle for the convenience of the permit holder who needs to enter or leave the vehicle.
7. The disability parking permit cannot be used by any person conducting business in the absence of the permit holder.
8. The disability parking permit remains the property of the issuing Council and must be returned within the specified time when requested to do so by the Council or an authorised officer.
9. A person can only hold one disability parking permit.
10. An organisation may hold more than one disability parking permit, however must justify in writing to Council the reasons for the request, the number of disability parking permits required and any increases in the number of permits required.
11. When requested by an authorised officer, a person using a disability parking permit must:
 - state his or her name and address; and
 - produce his or her driver’s licence; and
 - produce a current parking permit for people with disabilities or satisfy the police officer or authorised officer that he or she, or the passenger of the vehicle, holds a current parking permit for people with disabilities.

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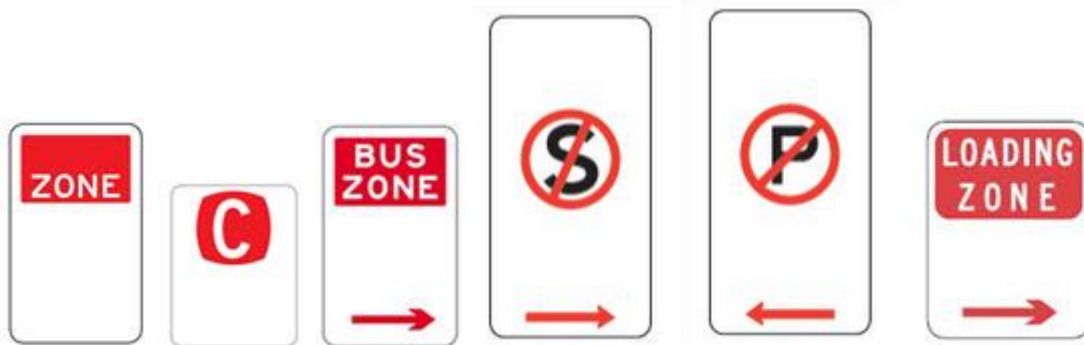


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Parking restrictions

1. A disability parking permit does not entitle the permit holder to free parking, unless stated on the permissive parking sign. Parking can differ between Councils, permit holders should always check the permissive parking signs.
2. A disability parking permit does not allow permit holders to park where there is a red restrictive parking signs such as; no stopping, no parking, clearway, bus zone, taxi zone, loading zone, permit zone, work zone.

3. A category one (blue) permit holder (driver/passenger) is entitled to park a vehicle:
 - in a reserved disability parking bay for the time displayed on the parking sign, or
 - in any ordinary timed parking bay for twice as long as the time displayed on the parking sign.

A category two (green) permit holder (driver/passenger) is entitled to park a vehicle:

- in any ordinary timed parking bay for twice as long as the time displayed on the parking sign.

Lost, stolen or damaged permits

If a permit is lost, stolen or damaged, the permit holder must contact us to determine renewal requirements.



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
