National Immunisation Program (NIP)

We offer free vaccines to everyone eligible under the National Immunisation Program (NIP). This includes anyone under the age of 20.

Other government funded programs

SCHOOL BASED PROGRAM

Year seven (12 to 13 years)

- Human papillomavirus (HPV) (Gardasil 9)
- Diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (Boostrix)

Year 10 (or age equivalent)

- Meningococcal ACWY

SEASONAL PROGRAM—INFLUENZA

- 65 years of age or older
- pregnant women
- Indigenous Australians from six months of age
- residents of nursing homes or other long-term care facilities
- all children from six months to less than five years of age
- people who have a medical risk factor

ADULT PROGRAMS

Measles-mumps-rubella

- people born since 1966 without a record of having two doses
- unvaccinated women planning pregnancy

Diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis

- pregnant women from 20 weeks gestation

Pneumococcal (PV13) (one dose)

- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islanders aged 50 years or older
- 70 years of age or older

Hepatitis B for at risk groups

Meningococcal ACWY for 15 to 19 years old not attending school

User-pays vaccines

- Influenza, seasonal program
- Diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (whooping cough)
- Hepatitis A for those aged 16 years or older
- Hepatitis B for those aged 20 years or older
- Hepatitis A and B for those aged 16 years or older
- Meningococcal ACWY
- Meningococcal B
- Pneumococcal

- Measles-mumps-rubella
- Varicella (chickenpox)
- Human papillomavirus (HPV)
