

Changes to in-home aged care

The Commonwealth Government is making significant changes to the in-home aged care system.

Due to these changes, Manningham Council, like many other Victorian councils, has made the difficult decision to no longer provide in-home aged care services from Wednesday 1 November.

These services include domestic help, personal care, respite care, Meals on Wheels and social support.

We want to reassure you that our older residents will still receive the services they need.

The Commonwealth Government will appoint new providers for Manningham. We will then work with our residents to ensure a smooth transition for them.

Considering a career in local government?

Did you know that there are paid graduate, intern, cadet, and traineeship roles available at Manningham Council? Positions are listed throughout the year and working with us provides great career opportunities.

When cadet engineer Hugh Martin was looking at options for an industry-based placement, he came across many stereotypes about what a career in local government would be like.

"I was told I'd be bored and that I'd spend my days with my feet up on the desk," he laughed.

As it turns out, this couldn't have been further from the truth.

"From day one, I was given a lot of responsibility and have been challenged by the range of projects and initiatives I've had the opportunity to work on."

Talking about the appeal of working as an engineer in local government, Hugh pointed to the variety of work that makes up his days. On a typical day, he might be working on traffic management or calculating parameters for consultants and developers (who rely on Council for data to inform design). He could be scrutinising plans submitted to Council for approval, street lighting, simple drainage and footpath designs and maintenance, and more.

Cadet engineers at Manningham have the chance to work on projects from beginning to end. From the design and community consultation stage all the way through to the tender process, implementation, and project delivery.

Fellow cadet engineer Rochelle Cabral agrees that the broad and varied work is a significant advantage of working in local government and was why she chose to do her industry-based placement at Manningham.

"I've been able to get experience in so many areas. From speaking directly with concerned residents to undertaking design work and honing my project management skills."

Recently, Rochelle was involved in working on a new drainage design for Andersons Creek Road in Doncaster. The project came about in response to community concern about flooding in the area.

Because of the practical experience she has gained, Rochelle is confident that by the end of the 12-month cadetship, she will have a clear idea of what area she would like to specialise in.

"I would really encourage any young person to consider working for local government. It's a good way to enter the industry, the conditions are great, and it's a supportive learning environment. You can also ask as many questions as you need without getting judged."

Hugh also says local government is a good option for people looking for a fulfilling and rewarding career that improves the lives of people in the community.

"It's very important that I leave a positive mark on the world. I like that this role gives me the chance to work on projects that matter to the community."

Our environment wins when we reduce FOGO contamination

Our Food Organics Garden Organics (FOGO) service is now in action!

FOGO is a state-wide initiative to cut waste and boost recycling. Using FOGO compost in our parks and gardens helps add nutrients to the soil and reduces weeds.

You've been doing a great job recycling your food waste. As we keep using our FOGO (green lid) bins, it's important that we only place food and garden waste in our FOGO bin.

Plastics, metals and clothing cannot be composted. These items significantly reduce the quality of the finished compost and go into your red lid garbage bin. Clothing in good condition can be donated to Op Shops.

To help you know what can and cannot go into your FOGO bin, we have a comprehensive A to Z FOGO guide on our website.

Better compost will mean healthier soils, improving our green spaces for Manningham residents.

GARDEN WASTE DISPOSAL DAYS

Do you live in a Bushfire Prone Area? To help you prepare for bushfire season, our garden waste days will be back during September, October and November.

You must live in a bushfire prone area to use this service. You can drop off either one car boot, station wagon, ute or a 6'x4' level trailer load.

There is an additional charge for any extra garden waste payable by EFT on the day.

You must show proof of residency (either a driver's licence or rates notice) at the check-in point on the day.

Planning for our future

Our 2023/24 Budget is delivering for our community. With an operating budget of \$147 million, we provide more than 100 valuable services. Although inflation (CPI) is forecast to be at least 4 per cent in 2023/24, our average general rate increase will be in line with the State Government's rate cap of 3.5 per cent.

We are conscious of cost-of-living pressures in our community and are offering over \$1 million of relief measures by capping the increase to the waste service charge, increasing our low-income rate rebate and introducing subsidies for school holiday programs.

These important documents outline how we will spend your rates on community services and infrastructure, so be sure to check them out.

We're also delivering on our Council Plan, including:



\$38 million for a healthy community



\$24 million for liveable places and spaces



\$22 million for a resilient environment



\$5 million for a vibrant prosperous economy

\$31 million for a well governed Council

We continue investing in our community infrastructure with an extensive \$54 million capital works program to maintain and enhance Council's \$2.5 billion of community assets. This is in addition to the \$20 million allocated to maintaining our important community assets.

We will also deliver on our *Climate Emergency* Response Plan to reduce the impacts of climate change. Proposed capital works spending includes \$13 million for circular economy (sustainability) initiatives over the next four years.

Here's some of the works this budget will deliver:



We have allocated \$2.48 million in our 2023/24 Budget for installing traffic signals at the intersection of Tram Road and Merlin Street in Doncaster.

The installation of signals will improve safety at the intersection by providing fully controlled turning movements and will reduce the speed on the approaches. The signals will also enable traffic to safely turn to and from Merlin Street, limiting the risk of collisions.



We have allocated \$2.3 million in our 2023/24 Budget to develop a park in the newly created reserve on the southside of Hepburn Road between Gifford and Gilmore Roads in Doncaster. The park will be developed as a predominantly green open space.

We are yet to consult with the community but it may include quality play opportunities, ample seating, perhaps paved seating area, barbecue, some shelter, paved pathways, lighting throughout, and significant areas of tree and shrub planting.



We have allocated \$1.5 million in our 2023/24 Budget to upgrade Melbourne Hill Road's drainage network. This will reduce the risk to property posed by future flood events while preserving the area's peri-urban nature.



We have allocated \$1.5 million in our 2023/24 Budget towards our continued work to upgrade Jumping Creek Road.

The works will improve traffic safety for pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers. Improvements to the drainage network will help manage the surface water.

CLIMATE EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

We have allocated \$13 million in our capital works program over the next four years for Circular Economy (sustainability) initiatives.

Major projects include:

- Solar Panel Installation Program
- Energy Efficient Public Lighting Program
- Major Road Lights LED and Smart Controls Retrofit
- Environmentally Sustainable Design Program
- Water initiatives
- Flood mapping.

FOOD ORGANICS GARDEN ORGANICS (FOGO)

FOGO commenced in July 2023 and is part of our commitment to take action on climate change and achieve our climate targets through reducing the amount of waste that goes into landfill.

FOGO means changes to household waste collection services, where green lid garden bins will be collected weekly and can now include both food waste and garden waste. Red lid garbage bins will be collected fortnightly.

MAJOR ROAD LIGHTS - LED AND SMART CONTROLS RETROFIT

We have allocated \$1.8 million in our 2023/24 Budget for installing LED lamps and smart controls in major road lights.

This is a significant part of Council's response to the current Climate Emergency and will reduce lamp failure rates and energy consumption.

For every \$100 we spend this year, we will spend this much in each area.

A win for snowboarder Scotty James in the 2022 Victorian **Sport Awards**

Congratulations to Warrandyte's Scotty James for winning the Frank Wilkes Award in the 2022 Victorian Sport Awards.

This award recognises a Victorian individual athlete who has achieved outstanding results in respect to performance/s at a national/ international level in the male category during the 2022 year.

Scotty's 2022 began when he won his fourth gold medal at the X-Games in Aspen in late January. He was then selected to compete for Australia at his fourth Winter Olympics and against a star-studded field, he produced a score of 92.50 with his second run to secure the silver medal, his second career Olympic medal. Wrapping up the calendar year at the World Cup in Copper Mountain, Colorado, Scotty performed one of the finest runs in halfpipe history to score 99.00 and win gold.

Congratulations also to Vicky Lewis from Doncaster Tennis Club for her nomination for the Gallagher Community Coach of the Year.

OVER 45 YEARS OLD AND EXPERIENCING KNEE PAIN?

A new study by La Trobe University Sport and Exercise Medicine Research Centre evaluates the effects of two different nutrition programs to reduce knee pain, improve quality of life and lower inflammation in the blood. The study will look at the effects of diet and nutrition and their potential to improve knee pain and quality of life.

Participation is free and participants will get free physical and functional assessments, free dietary advice, a free DEXA scan and free blood testing.

Breathing new life into Andersons Creek

Fourth Hill in Warrandyte is a popular attraction for panners hoping to strike gold. But Gold Memorial Road has been attracting more than hopeful panners over the last decade.

The Andersons Creek Landcare Group volunteers are working to rehabilitate the native vegetation along Andersons Creek and encourage the return of local fauna.

Each Wednesday, volunteers pull on their gardening gloves and lace up their soil-coated boots before heading out for a morning of weeding or planting indigenous vegetation followed by the essential chit-chat and morning tea.

Looking at the area, you wouldn't be able to tell that only a few short years ago, it was dominated by Blue Periwinkle and other notorious invasive weeds.

Along the creek towering manna gums provide habitat for local koalas while the understory of shrubs, wildflowers and native grasses support birds, butterflies and lizards.

Andersons Creek Landcare Group recently helped run butterfly surveys with the Threatened Species Conservancy. Volunteers were rewarded by learning how to identifying, photograph and at times catch different butterfly species before letting them fly away.
