What an amazing experience it was hosting the 2023 Mayoral Charity Gala. I want to acknowledge and give special thanks to our partner MannaCare, and Gold sponsor Noel Jones Doncaster. Thank you for supporting the Gala and Manningham residents living with dementia.

Seeing so many people show up on the night to help raise funds was humbling. Everyone who participated was pivotal in bringing the Gala to life – so thank you! I look forward to the future as we continue working with our partner MannaCare to create 'Memory Lane' cafés for residents in Manningham.

I hope the cafés will offer a safe space for carers and families to take their loved ones. 'Memory Lane' cafés help reduce the impact of social isolation, anxiety and the stigma that can come with having dementia or caring for someone with the disease. As the cafés progress, we'll be sure to share updates in future issues of Manningham Matters.

I would also like to thank our community for moving to our Food Organics Garden Organics (FOGO) service. You've done such a great job of adjusting to this transition.

Already we've seen promising early results, with a reduction in landfill and an increase in FOGO tonnage. July, our first month of FOGO, saw 97 per cent of garbage bins being put out for collection on the correct days. We've also seen a 98.62 per cent increase in residents using their green bin – what a great effort! Read more at manningham.vic.gov. au/FOGO

As you know, earlier this year we made the difficult decision to exit in-home aged care services on 31 October 2023. This was due to significant Commonwealth Government changes in this sector.

We are pleased to let you know the Commonwealth Government has appointed new in-home aged care service providers for Manningham residents. We are now supporting our existing clients to move to these new providers. We have a team to help clients and ensure they continue receiving the services they need. Did you know the Warrandyte Library now has extended self-service hours? This makes it the perfect place for both early birds and night owls to find a quiet place to study or work.

To access the library after hours, you must be 18 years or over, a library member and have completed an induction session. The session will run you through how to access the service, safety measures in place and guidelines for use. To book your induction session, contact the library during regular staffed hours.

The Open Library program means the library will be accessible during extended hours, seven days a week (including Sundays and public holidays), in addition to the current staffed operating hours.

During self-service times, you'll be able to access the library's resources and facilities, including borrowing library collections, public computers, Wi-Fi, printing, photocopying, reading and study spaces.

The Open Library is funded by Manningham Council and is supported by the State Government of Victoria Living Libraries Infrastructure Program.

Building our resilience through water management

Water is fundamental to the health and wellbeing of our community and the liveability of Manningham.

Southern Australia is forecast to receive less annual rainfall on average in coming years. This will reduce water availability from water supply catchments. Water demand is also expected to increase as our City grows.

Yet, our changing climate is also expected to bring greater intensity rainfall events, increasing our flood risk and periods of low rainfall with increased drought risk.

We're working on various flood and stormwater management initiatives to build a more resilient and liveable Manningham.

Part of this work includes developing a draft Integrated Water Management Strategy. It will respond to emerging water challenges and identify opportunities to adapt to a more water constrained future.

Earlier this year, we invited you to take part in Manningham's Water Future survey. Thank you to those of you who shared how you use and conserve water and why it's important to you.

Your responses paint a picture of a community that strongly values the Birrarung (the Yarra River) and our creeks, our environment and wildlife.

"Our local waterways are what connects us and they connect with the bays and oceans which make up 70 per cent of our planet. Water is essential to our survival."

You also told us some of the ways you're already taking action to build our resilience and conserve water.

- **98%** of respondents use front load washing machines, use dual flush toilets or only run washing machines with full loads.
- 41% of respondents use rainwater collected from private roofs for watering gardens, toilet flushing, carwashing and other uses.

"The waterways are a deeply treasured part of our community heritage."

More than 85 per cent of respondents also support the use of alternative water sources for garden watering, toilet flushing and laundry purposes.

These opportunities will be a key focus of the Manningham Integrated Water Management Strategy, which will be available for public exhibition in mid-2024.

Top three reasons why the Birrarung (Yarra River) and Manningham creeks and lakes are important to survey respondents:

- 1. Provide wildlife habitat and support biodiversity
- 2. Promote connections with nature to support mental health and wellbeing
- 3. Assist with cooling during hot weather and improve neighbourhood liveability.



2023 Referendum First Nations Voice to Parliament

The Federal Government's planned referendum will be an opportunity for every Australian to make their own decision.

The Voice to Parliament was a key recommendation of the Uluru Statement from the Heart. The Statement was a document written and endorsed by First Nations leaders in 2017 to change the Constitution to improve the representation of Indigenous Australians.

This document called for an advisory body, called "the Voice", to advise parliament and the Federal Government on Indigenous policy matters including health, education, economic disadvantage and social matters. On Saturday 14 October, a referendum will be held on whether to change the Constitution to recognise the First Peoples of Australia by establishing an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice.

What does this mean?

The referendum will be an opportunity for every Australian to make their own decision about a First Nations Voice to Parliament.

The referendum question, approved by parliament in June is:

"A Proposed Law: to alter the Constitution to recognise the First Peoples of Australia by establishing an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice. Do you approve this proposed alteration?"

The proposed constitutional amendment would insert the following lines into the Constitution:

"Chapter IX Recognition of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples

129 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice

In recognition of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples as the First Peoples of Australia:

- i. there shall be a body, to be called the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice;
- ii. the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice may make representations to the Parliament and the Executive Government of the Commonwealth on matters relating to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples;
- iii. the Parliament shall, subject to this Constitution, have power to make laws with respect to matters relating to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice, including its composition, functions, powers and procedures."

What are your responsibilities?

A referendum is an important democratic process, and the only way in which Australia's constitution can be changed. Every person has the responsibility to undertake their own research, and make their own decision, in order to vote on the referendum.

The content of the pamphlet was supplied by the respective parliamentary committees who wrote each case. If you are eligible to vote, but not yet registered, you can register through the Australian Electoral Commission.

Container Deposit Scheme coming soon to Manningham

From November, new reverse vending machines (RVMs) will open across Manningham, meaning we'll soon be able to recycle in an even bigger way.

Once registered you'll be able to stop by one of these machines, deposit your eligible containers and reap rewards. Each eligible container will earn a refund of ten cents. It's a great way for sporting clubs, community groups and not for profit organisations to also get involved and start fundraising.

The Container Deposit Scheme (CDS Vic) is a State Government initiative, as part of the Recycling Victoria Policy. CDS Vic will reduce one of the most littered items, beverage containers. It's a win-win – you'll get something back while also reducing waste going to landfill.

Once CDS Vic is operating, everyone who has registered will be able to deposit all eligible containers at RVMs across Manningham – with a total capacity of about 33,000 daily containers.

The scheme will also help us achieve our Climate Emergency Response Plan goal of net zero community emissions by 2035.

New public art for wonguim wilam

If you're strolling along the banks of the Birrarung [Yarra River] in Warrandyte, you may have noticed new public art taking shape at wonguim wilam.

Prominent Melbourne-based fine artist, muralist and creative, Simone Thomson has been commissioned for the work, creating shared meaning and connection to place.

A Wurundjeri Woi-wurrung and Yorta-Yorta Traditional Owner through her mother, Simone's art is inspired by her spiritual connection to Country and the rich colours and textures of the earth and sky.

The work comprises two parts, an entrance sculpture and Gathering Circle, and strongly embraces themes of culture, community and country.

Simone said "This Gathering Circle will represent the importance of community and the preservation of cultural practices to the oldest continuous culture on Earth"

"It will be a place of reflection on Country and offer a peaceful connection to the lands and waterways in which it sits along the beautiful Birrarung, the river of mist and shadows".

The work will be the first permanent public artwork delivered as part of our Public Art Policy.

Mayor, Cr. Deirdre Diamante said "When it comes to public art, it's important that we consider the works' appearance within the context of what inspired it and the story it is telling. Through the Gathering Circle, Simone is extending the whole community an open invitation to come together, connect and reflect on the incredible cultural significance of Warrandyte.

This art is also functional and immersive, providing a special place for residents and visitors to do just that."

Council conducted the commission in consultation with Wurundjeri Woi-wurrung Cultural Heritage Aboriginal Corporation.

Mullum Mullum Stadium breaks barriers with accessibility upgrades for wheelchair sports

Mullum Mullum Stadium has embraced inclusivity by undergoing an accessibility upgrade. As a part of the upgrade we've put in new widened and automatic doors at courts and changeroom facilities.

A recent surge in wheelchair sports participation prompted the upgrade. The new doors will help to provide equal access and opportunities for all athletes.

The new doors cater to athletes who use a wider set wheelchair during sport. The stadium is now fit for purpose to host wheelchair basketball, rugby, and football competitions.

In collaboration with Disability Sport and Recreation, this upgrade at Mullum Mullum Stadium represents a proactive step in our commitment to creating accessible and inclusive sporting opportunities for the whole community.

How many chickens can I keep in my backyard? I'm a café owner, how do I get rid of food waste safely? I want to film or take photos in Manningham for commercial purposes, do I need a permit?

These are some of the questions covered by our Community Local Law. This is the set of laws made by each Council to protect the land, buildings, health and safety of our community.

We update the Community Local Law every 10 years and it covers areas including

- · keeping animals
- · protecting the natural environment
- · lighting fires on your property
- · waste management
- · drainage

We have now updated the Manningham Community Local Law for 2023. To make sure you know what the new law covers, please visit **yoursay.manningham.vic.gov.au/new-local-law-2023** to find out more.

Answers to the above questions!

- a. Under the proposed new Community Local Law, you can keep five chickens without a permit if your land is 500-1199 square metres. No roosters are allowed.
- b. There are several laws that owners of food businesses should be aware of. If this is you, it's best to read the local laws on waste disposal.
- c. If you are filming or taking photos in Manningham for commercial purposes you do need a permit.

CHANGE YOUR CLOCK AND YOUR SMOKE ALARM BATTERIES




