Day and night works

Maintenance hole construction on Bulleen Road, Bulleen

We're moving close to 100 above and underground services such as power, water, gas, sewer and telecommunications to make way for North East Link.

From **Thursday 20 May 2021** until **late 2021** CPB Contractors will establish a work site on the eastern side of Bulleen Road, south of Golden Way, Bulleen to support the construction of the Yarra East Main Sewer.

What we'll be doing

Works will include:

- Vegetation removal
- Construction of a crushed rock base for the work area
- Installation of temporary site facilities and toilets
- Construction of shafts using large machinery
- Boring and the installation of sewer sections using a small drilling machine
- Construction of three maintenance holes on the eastern side of Bulleen Road for the ongoing inspection and maintenance of the new sewer
- Construction of a fourth maintenance hole at Ilma Court following the completion of the eastern side maintenance holes.

Long-term pedestrian and cyclist detour on Bulleen Road

There will be a long-term footpath and bike lane closure on Bulleen Road between Golden Way to Trinity Grammar School's Marles Playing Fields, from **Monday 17 May** until **late 2021**.

A pedestrian and cyclist detour will be in place diverting users along Golden Way, Rocklea Road, Barak Street and Thompsons Road.

Traffic management and appropriate signage will be in place to advise users of the closure and detour

When are we working?

7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday

Night works:

6pm to 6am Sunday to Saturday

From **Thursday 20 May 2021** until **late 2021**.

Incidental night works may be required for large deliveries and moving large equipment. Southbound lanes may be closed during this time.

Impacted residents will be advised in advance.

What to expect

During these works you may notice:

- Work crews in the area
- Noise from machinery and equipment, such as an excavator, roller, drilling rig, crane and light vehicles
- Vibration while we compact the work area
- A new variable speed limit of 60km/h and 40km/h will be in place on Bulleen Road during these works.

- Tree protection zones to retain as many trees as possible.

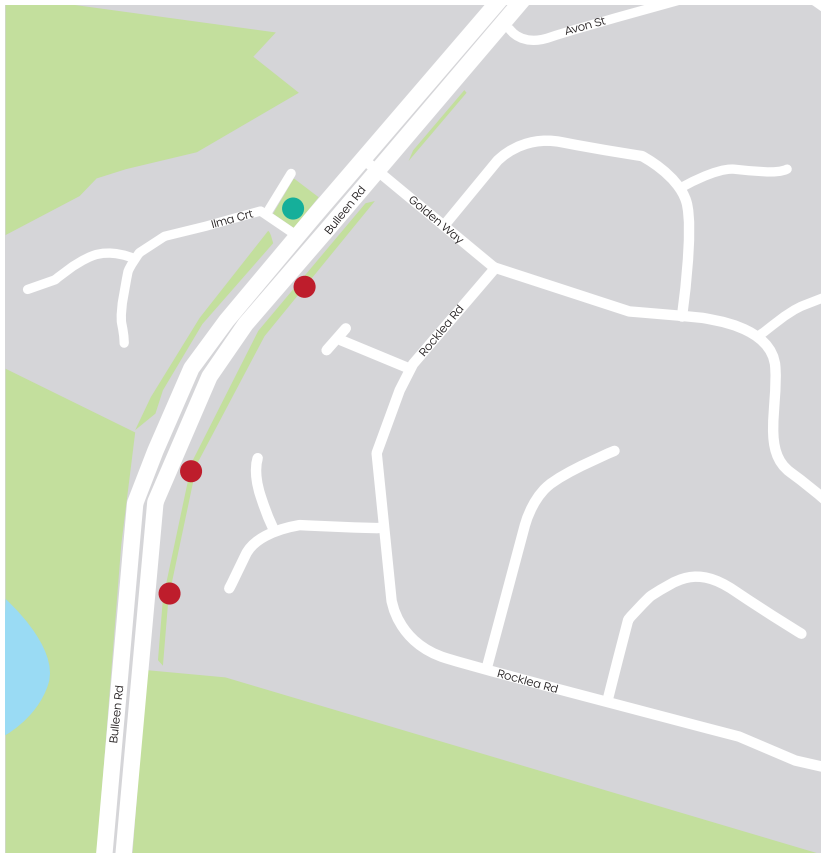
Our community engagement team will be onsite and available to assist residents during the works.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.

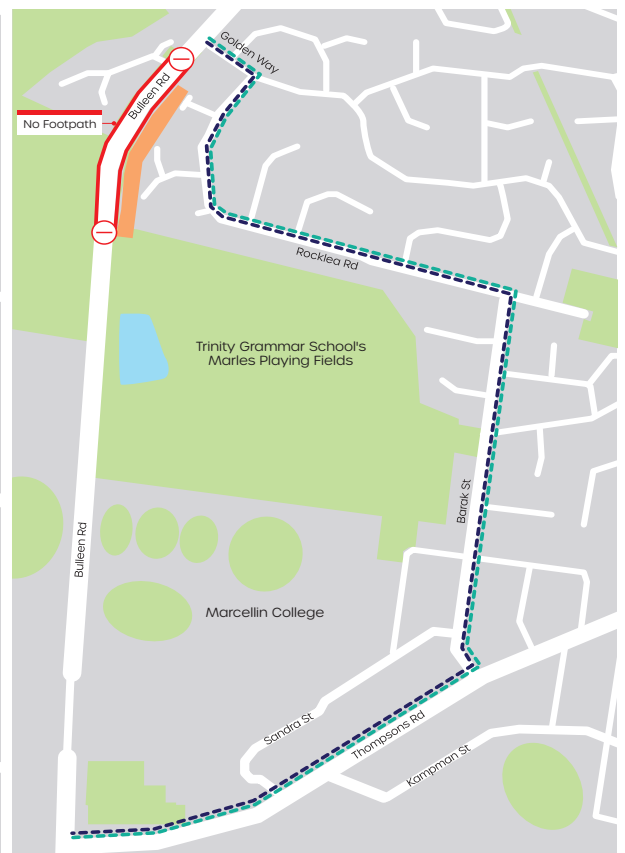
Bulleen Road Maintenance Holes
