

# Upcoming day and night works for North East Link

## Shaft construction and tunnelling works continue at Avon Street, Bulleen and the Bulleen Road/Greenaway Street car park, Bulleen

From **Thursday 10 June** until **late 2021**, we will continue to construct retrieval shafts at Avon Street and at the Bulleen Road/Greenaway Street car park. Following these works, we will construct a tunnel between the two shafts.

### What we're doing

Works include:

- Construction of receival shafts at Avon Street and at the Bulleen Road/Greenaway Street car park ready for retrieving a mini Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) in mid-2021
- Removal of material from the middle of the shafts at both Avon Street and Bulleen Road, using a rock breaker if there are difficult ground conditions
- Construction of a tunnel that runs between Avon Street and the Bulleen Road/Greenaway Street car park
- Retrieval of the mini TBM at the Avon Street shaft
- Construction of maintenance holes
- Commissioning and reinstatement of work site.

### When we'll be working

Work hours will increase to 24 hour operations, **6am** Monday until **6pm** Saturday, from **Thursday 10 June 2021**.

### What to expect

During these works you may notice:

- Work crews in the area
- Light from the work site
- Noise from machinery and equipment, such as an excavator, bobcat, generator, vehicles, piling rig and rock breakers
- A crane to lift and place pipes to assist with the tunnel construction between Avon Street and Greenaway Street
- Dust from the work site
- A variable speed limit of 60km/h and 40 km/h will be in place on Bulleen Road during this period.

### Managing impacts

CPB Contractors are committed to minimising construction impacts for residents and will implement the following mitigation measures where appropriate.

- Covering loads on trucks, when transporting excavated material
- Directional lighting to avoid light spill
- Dust suppression using water carts and binding agents
- Noise control equipment and sound blankets may be used on machinery and tools
- Tree protection zones to retain as many trees as possible
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place around the work site
- Traffic management will be in place near the works to guide you safely through the area.

### Health and safety
