

Upcoming day and night works for North East Link

Continuation of tunnelling activities at Manningham Hotel & Club, Bulleen.

CPB Contractors will continue tunnelling activities at Manningham Hotel & Club, Bulleen, from **Tuesday 10 August 2021** to support construction of the Yarra East Main Sewer (YEMS).

What we're doing

Ongoing works include:

- Setting up the retrieval shaft in preparation for receiving the mini Tunnel Boring Machine that is tunnelling from the Boroondara Tennis Centre
- Continuing with the construction of a reticulation sewer, including boring the pipeline between the maintenance holes
- Continuing with maintenance hole construction including the setup and monitoring of a sewer bypass
- Testing and commissioning of the sewer network
- Reinstatement works.

When we're working

Tunnelling operations will start from **Tuesday 10 August 2021** and will continue until **October 2021**.

Work hours will change to **24/7** hour operations, from **Tuesday 10 August** and will continue until **October 2021**.

What to expect

During works you may notice:

- Work crews in the area, including construction traffic accessing the worksite off Thompsons Road in addition to Bulleen Road

- Light from the worksite
- Noise from machinery and equipment, such as an excavator, bobcat, generator, slurry separation unit and vehicles
- Dust from the worksite.

Managing impacts

CPB Contractors are committed to minimising construction impacts for the venue and will implement the following mitigation measures where appropriate:

- Covering loads on trucks, when transporting excavated material
- Directional lighting to avoid light spill
- Dust suppression using water carts and binding agents
- Noise control equipment and sound blankets may be used on machinery and tools
- Tree protection zones to retain as many trees as possible.

Our community engagement team will be onsite and available to assist patrons during the works. Safety is our priority and we ask for your assistance with obeying instructions, signage, and maintaining social distancing during the coronavirus pandemic.

The phasing of these works is indicative only and subject to change within the times specified in the works notification.
